<b>Chromebook Fees and Repairs</b>							
As part of their participation in the Chromebook program, students will pay an annual nonrefundable Technology Fee of \$25.00 The District will use the following guidelines for determining costs associated with repairs/replacements:							
*In the case of damage, the District will charge a minimum fee of \$5 and a maximum fee of \$25 for each Chromebook repair.							
*The District will charge the student the full costs of replacing any lost or damaged bags and chargers.							
*The student will be charged the full cost of repair if it is determined that damages occurred by intentional misuse or abuse.							
*The student will be held responsible for the full replacement cost of the Chromebook if it is lost or stolen (approximately \$355.00).
