Course Objectives: This class is 30 minutes per day for 1 quarter. It is designed to provide students with the opportunity to learn new and extra historical information outside of the state mandated 8th grade history curriculum. Though we will learn about a variety of historical topics, events, and figures, it is my goal to highlight areas of interest for students.

Course Description: This class is a social studies enrichment class. We will focus on time periods and historical figures we may not otherwise have a chance to study in depth during the school year in regular history class. We have more freedom to study what we would like and how we would like during this time period.

Textbook/Resources/Topics: No textbooks will be issued to students for this class. Materials for discussion will come from a wide variety of sources provided in class.

Homework and Assignments Policy: All homework and assignments will be due when I call for them. Assignments should be neat and legible or they will receive no credit. (I reserve the right to make specific exceptions on late work in emergency situations.)

Evaluation Process: Grades include daily assignments, bell work, class projects, quizzes, activities, and participation in class activities.

Extra Credit: There will be some extra credit points built into certain assignments. It will be up to the individual student to take advantage of these opportunities when they are given. Extra credit will not be given to students who come at the end of a grading period looking for more points.

Cheating: If a student is caught cheating, he/she will receive a **zero** on the assignment and a parent/guardian will be notified. Some examples of cheating include:

- Using another students' work to complete your own-in this instance *both* students will receive a zero
- Using notes or cheat sheet on a quiz or test when it is not permitted

Make-up work and Absences: If a student is absent, it is his or her responsibility to check with me to find out what work they may have missed. Please be sure to read the policy in the student handbook on make-up work. This is the policy that will be followed. Good attendance is crucial to be successful in any class. Each day we will build on information from previous weeks and days. Regular attendance is a must!

Additional Help: If a student needs help outside of class, please let me know as soon as possible! I am available certain times both before and after school, and am more than willing to work with different schedules. If there are questions or problems on a specific assignment, project, or topic, don't wait until the assignment is due to ask for help.
